Participants will be notified of acceptance by the end of **June 2016**.

Full version of the paper based on the accepted proposal should be submitted to the Head of the Department by **1st July 2016**.

Final version of the paper after incorporating the feedback of the conference must be submitted by **15th September 2016**.

Accepted papers will be published in the Conference Proceedings.
