Location: HANDS Centre at TU

This is a one-week vocational workshop organized by the HANDS project Centre at Tishreen University. It was a highly engaging session for students, it aimed at providing practical application experiences in designing and manufacturing of Geometric Patterns, fostering creativity and skill development among the participants.

The objectives outlined for the workshop were well-structured:

Introduction Geometric pattern design: Introducing the students to the techniques related to geometric pattern design in terms of proportional concepts that are related to the golden ratio as well as the proportional rectangles.

Hands-on Activities: Engaging the students in a practical application to reinforce learning process. Designing and manufacturing a geometric pattern that is applicable to interior and architectural design process provided a tangible and hands-on experience, allowing participants to apply their knowledge directly using the machines and equipment within the HANDS centre.

Innovation in Pattern Design Applications: Encouraging creativity and innovation in traditional pattern designs is essential in fostering artistic expression. This objective likely stimulated participants to think outside conventional boundaries, resulting in unique and creative designs.
