The final Conference and exhibition of the Traditional Craft Heritage Training, Design and Marketing in Jordan and Syria (HANDS) project that lasted for four years was launched at Al-Zaytoonah University of Jordan on 11-12/10/2023 under the patronage of the President of Al-zaytoonah University and the President of AL Baath University.

Dr. Tariq El-Qirim, the vice president of Al-Zaytoonah University on behalf of the ZUJ president, stated that HANDS project at Al-Zaytoonah University has a goal of developing students' competences to meet the demands of the local and regional job markets. The focus on developing the content of selected courses and incorporating special vocational courses suggests a commitment to providing students with practical and job market-relevant skills. HANDS aims at enhancing innovation in the design fields indicates a recognition of the importance of creativity and cutting-edge approaches in design-related disciplines. This project aligns with the broader trend in education towards preparing students for real-world challenges and ensuring that they are competitive in the evolving job market.


