The second Point of activities was delivered by Architect Prof. Nidal Satouf. Briefly About the contents of his word:

The craft, in its linguistic meaning, is a name that expresses the professionalism and practice of any handicraft, and the traditional crafts are as old as human history and are created by the human need for it. The handicrafts began to reflect the feelings and characteristics of a society, and take the character of people and the environment that make up that country. In addition, because each country has a distinct artistic feature and cultural characteristics, the crafts were distinguished between countries and took the description (traditional).

Traditional industries are defined as those industries with a historical extension that are based on converting the raw material into a manufactured product that reflects a heritage character so that these products carry historical or religious expressions and features.
