HANDS Courses committee meeting With Stakeholders (Craft society) Al-Zaytoonah University of Jordan


<u>Amman-Jordan</u> <u>August Wednesday 26th, 2020</u>


2nd Online STC meeting WP10: Management and Operational Structures

Date: 24/9/2020.




During the meeting, Work package leaders presented the progress in the work packages of HANDS Project. Also they pointed out what is required from partners.


The meeting was attended by representatives from the all partner universities in Jordan, Syria, Spain, Italy, and Germany.
