
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Princess Sumaya Bint El Hassan Sponsors the 8th International Conference on Engineering, Project, and Production Management (EPPM 2017)



Her Royal Highness (HRH) Princess Sumaya bint El Hassan, President of the Royal Scientific Society, patronized the 8th International Conference on Engineering, Project, and Production Management (EPPM 2017) held at the University in cooperation with the International Society for Engineering Projects and Production Management (EPPM).

HRH stressed the importance of managing engineering projects in all scientific applications in our lives. HRH added that due to the rapid progress of technology, it is hard to separate science from each other as they all share solutions to the problems facing the world today.

HRH commended the role of Jordan in hosting such conferences because of its importance in the progress of projects that contribute to the production and management. HRH appreciated the role played by the International Society for Engineering Projects and Production Management (EPPM) in spreading the importance of projects and production management in the world.

The President of the University, Dr. Turki Obaidat, affirmed that the patronage of HRH reflects the interest of the Hashemite leadership and the Jordanian Government in developing the fields of engineering, technology and knowledge economy, in order to improve productivity and investment in the business environment and to promote competitiveness within the comprehensive and sustainable national development process.

The president also added that the opening ceremony, which was attended by the Chairman of the Board of Trustees Mr. Eid Al Fayez, coincides with the University receiving the ISO certificate in all its academic and administrative components, to be the first Jordanian university to obtain this certificate in its modern version focusing on leadership and risk management. This feat also coincides with the acquisition of the Jordan Quality Assurance Certificates by the Faculties of Pharmacy and Nursing . These accreditations are based upon great achievements in







strategic planning, sound governance, academic programs, scientific research, innovation, and outstanding human resources management. In addition, these certificates show the exceptional quality achieved in student services, community service, and external relations. This is combined with an efficient and effective system to manage quality assurance at the university level.

The president also pointed out that Al-Zaytoonah University is one of the best universities in Jordan in terms of scientific research spending relative to its budget. The University had increased its expenditure on scientific research to about one million Jordanian Dinars in 2016. The current research legislations support scientific research projects which are consistent with the national research priorities and the needs of industrial and service sectors.

The president also added that the university holds four conferences annually. This allows the researchers in the university to collaborate and network with researchers around the world, and enhance the competitiveness of the university.

The conference was organized by the

Faculty of Engineering and Technology and the Faculty of Business.

The conference was a two-day conference focusing on the following themes:

- Project and Process Management
- Risk Management
- Engineering Management
- Logistics and Supply Chain Management
- Operational Management and Decision Support Systems
- Transportation Systems
- Cost Analysis and Financial Management
- Environmental Science and Management
- · Quality and Reliability Management
- Construction Management
- Maintenance Management Systems

The conference had attracted quality research contributions from researchers from several countries around the world including Turkey, United Kingdom, South Africa, Iraq, Iran, Canada, Poland, Taiwan, Singapore, United States, Algeria, Australia, Afghanistan, Thailand, India, Greece and Jordan. Accepted papers at this conference will be published in Springers.

University celebrates the graduation of the twenty first batch of the summer semester for the academic year 2016/2017



The President of the University Dr. Turki Obaidat delivered a speech during the ceremony which held under the patronage of H.E. Mr. Eid Al-Fayez, the chairman of the Board of Trustees.

Dr. Obaidat stressed that the university will remain a pioneer in promoting national unity and the comprehensive development process under the banner of the Hashemite leadership of His Majesty King Abdullah II Ibn Al Hussein.

He pointed out that the university has received the ISO certificate in all its academic and administrative components, to be the first Jordanian university to obtain this certificate in its modern version, which focuses on leadership and risk management. In addition, both the Pharmacy and Nursing faculties have obtained the Jordanian Quality Assurance Certificate granted by the Accreditation and Quality Assurance Commission for Higher Educational Institutions.

He added that the university has

achieved tangible achievements in order to reflect its vision, mission and goals. In the second semester of the academic year 2016/2017, it obtained advanced positions among the Jordanian universities in the universities proficiency exam in many academic disciplines. It came first in management information systems, multimedia systems, Mathematics, communications and computer engineering. It came second







in pharmacy, Arabic language and French language. And third in business administration and mechanical engineering. These results confirm the proper planning, implementation and evaluation of the teaching / learning process, and clearly indicate the efficiency of the teaching staff and the quality of learning outcomes.

The president announced that The University took over the presidency of the Jordanian Universities Sports Union from the beginning of the academic year 2017/2018 for two years.

He also pointed to the great efforts exerted to improve the university environment and reduce student violence. The completion of a number of important projects to include solar energy project, student's sustainable



green garden, the kindergarten building and the electronic gates project.

The University has signed agreements with many national institutions to include, the Jordan Transparency Center, Justice Center for Legal Aid and the Oxford Academy to provide students with the necessary skills needed for the labor market.

The Faculties of Pharmacy and Nursing Receive Quality Assurance Certificates from the Accreditation and Quality Assurance Commission for Higher Education Instututions



The Faculties of Pharmacy and Nursing at the University received a certificate of quality assurance which was granted by the Higher Education Accreditation Commission, becoming the first university in Jordan to receive these certificates. The Head of Accrediting Authority Dr. Bashir Al-Zu'bi, confirmed the importance of this achievement, the first of its kind at the level of both public and private universities in Jordan, in which Al-Zaytoonah University was the first national institutions to obtain this certificate. This helps in accrediting academic programs and students in choosing their specialties based on the certificates granted to each program. Quality Assurance certificates contributes to obtaining international quality assurance certificates and aids universities in the Jordanian ranking of universities.

Dr. Zu'bi called for activating the role of the accreditation and quality assurance which distinguishes between specializations and programs, aiming at doubling the number of foreign students studying in the kingdom during the next five years as mandated by the Council of Ministers. The Quality Assurance Certification reflects positively on the higher education sector in Jordan in line with the directives of His Majesty King Abdullah II.

On his part, President of Al-Zaytoonah



University, Dr. Turki Obaidat thanked the Chairman and members of the Board of the Commission, for their efforts in enhancing the level of higher education and introducing the quality assurance system as a basic component in the Jordanian higher education sector, which is reflected positively in improving the level of educational outputs.

He added that the university has obtained this achievement based on sound strategic planning, starting from the need for an integrated management system to ensure quality at the university level. He also added "we believed that quality is a culture of excellence and we realized from the beginning that the student is the focus of the educational process in terms of quality". The University has strengthened the system of legislation, strategic planning and governance based on justice, integrity, transparency and vision.

He added that in the field of scientific research at Al-Zaytoonah University spent more than 3% of its budget to support institutional scientific research. The number of papers published by university faculty in international journals has doubled over the last three years. He stressed the importance of sound financial planning starting with faculties and departments and ending with the university as a whole. He pointed out that the university has obtained the ISO 9001: 2015 certificate, which focuses on leadership and risk management.

Dr. Obaidat called on the public and private universities to adopt this approach because there is a big difference between accreditation and quality assurance and he asserted that quality assurance is a much greater process of accreditation because it improves the level of the graduate and enhances the university's competitiveness on the national, regional and international levels.

At the end of the ceremony, Dr. Obaidat thanked the staff of the Office of Quality Assurance and acknowledged the contributions of the teaching and administrative staff on these achievements.



The University receives ISO 9001: 2015 Certificate

Al-Zaytoonah University of Jordan obtained the ISO 9001: 2015 certificate in all its academic and administrative components, and was the first Jordanian university to obtain this certificate in its updated version.

This certificate has been achieved by the efforts of faculty members and administrative and technical staff. Moreover, the university is keeping on the process of development and modernization to reach its strategic goals in teaching, scientific research and community service.



The University enters the global classification Green Metric

The university has entered the 2016 UI World Metric ranking among 500 universities.

The university's interest in this classification was to achieve international standards in the fields of environment and sustainable development. This should enhance the facilities and infrastructure environments to promote clean energy, management of solid and liquid waste, optimal use of water, efficient transportation. This can be achieved through the incorporation of sustainable development in education.

The University President Dr. Turki Obaidat pointed out that the process of learning and teaching is a continuous process and that the student is the leader of this process. in refining the personality and the spirit of the students and is a sign of the beginning of future success. He added that this day is important in establishing the valuable foundations for the future of the Faculty of Engineering and Technology to obtain the ABET accreditation with the cooperation of faculty members and students. A number of posters for graduation design projects were exhibited and winners were honored by the university president. The university receives distinguished results in the proficiency exam

ZUJ has achieved advanced positions in the proficiency exam for the first semester in academic year 2016/2017. 

The president also highlighted the role of the university In community service through the offering of free medical days.








Dr. Obaidat also added that the university has recently has established the Faculty of Architecture and Design, and has embarked on a unique specialization in alternative energy technology.
