Abstract

This study aimed to know the The Legal System for the registration and production of the international trademark which is considered one of the most important means of international protection, where the trademark requesting international protection is registered in all countries by means of a single registration and in one language, it is submitted to the registrar of current marks in the country of origin, whose role is to transfer to The Office of the International Registration in the world, and the researcher used the descriptive and analytical approach as this registration was described, its procedures and conditions were described, the legal effects it arranged, and the legal texts were analyzed to show its legal basis in international conventions.

This study reached several conclusions, the most important of which is that all countries must join the Madrid System and the Madrid Protocol in order to provide a broader protection for the trademark, and that the Madrid System and the Madrid Protocol provide a text that the trademark owner is entitled to renew the term of protection, similar to the TRIPS Agreement that was given to the owner.
