A comparative study between Jordanian and Qatari legislations

This study examines the fraud cybercrimes in light of the Qatari law and the Jordanian law given their great importance and the various cybercrimes committed through the internet. Thus, it was necessary to study this subject within a comparative framework as stated by the Qatari and Jordanian legislators. This study is divided into three chapters. The first chapter dealt with the nature of fraud cybercrimes and determining their characteristic showing that they differ from the traditional cybercrimes since they are electronic. The second chapter examined the pillars and kinds of fraud cybercrimes showing many points in common between the fraud cybercrimes and the traditional cybercrimes where the two adopt fraud and deception, and they are committed for money and the criminal's goal is seizing the money of others with the intention of possession and depriving others from it. The third chapter tackles the procedural framework for the crime of legal fraud showing that the fraud cybercrimes are difficult to be proven since they require national and international efforts to confront and reduce this crime.
